




Library News

Updated Services Beginning July 6!

- The Library building is open for computer use, printing, photocopying, and limited physical browsing beginning Monday, July 6. Hours are:
 - Mon., Tues., Weds.: 10am-12:30pm and 1:30-7pm
 - Thurs., Fri.: 10am-12:30pm and 1:30-5pm
- Curbside services will continue to be available.
- Masks and social distancing are strongly recommended. The Library will be at a 20-person browsing capacity. **Green** sign means the library is accessible, **red** means the library is at full capacity. We ask that you limit your browsing to under 30 minutes.
- If computer assistance is requested, patrons will be required to wear a mask and provided one if needed. Assistance will be limited. Staff will not be able to sit with patrons, touch the keyboards or mice.
- If physical browsing assistance is requested, patrons will be asked to wear a mask or maintain a social distance of 6 feet.
- Restrooms, study rooms, and small conference room are not available.
- We will be accepting returns in bins located by the circulation desk, bins near the Library's main entrance, and via the book drop. All items returned will be quarantined for 72 hours per CDC guidelines.
- Items may be ordered via your library account online. If calling the library to place your order, please continue to limit your requests so that we may better accommodate everyone.
- WISCAT remains unavailable.

If you feel ill, please stay home! We thank you for your patience as we move safely forward with this process!
