

Our community and The Jackson County History Room have benefited in so many ways from local authors/writers. Whether they pertain to local history, social activities, individuals, government and education, or a host of numerous other topics, their writings have reached readers near and far.

Many of you are familiar with the writing of local historian Paul Rykken. Through his leadership, the Falls History Project, which he spearheaded as a teacher for the Black River Falls School District, has produced 20 community Projects. A sideline to these Projects, Paul has authored several individual articles.

In the Autumn issue of the *Wisconsin Magazine of History*, Paul's article, *Spaulding's Funeral*, was featured. The hours of research, writing, and editing for this writing were overwhelming and uncountable. The story received great reviews and told the intriguing story of the funeral of the man credited for being the founder of Black River Falls. Each year, the Wisconsin Historical Society (WHS) *Magazine of History* awards the William B. Hesseltine Award in memory of this late historian and past WHS president.
