Discussion about costs and equal treatment for all medical facilities in the area concluded with an approval for providing library related inserts to put into the books the clinic provides. No bags purchased.

Director Cara Hart requested approval to attend ARSL conference 2022 pending her acceptance as a scholarship recipient through the conference. Sarah made a motion to approve her attendance pending scholarship. Grady seconded. Carried.

Pending Director Hart's attendance at ARSL, a previously scheduled event would need to be moved to Sunday, September 18, 2022 due to schedule conflicts. This item was tabled to the July 2022, Library Board meeting.

2 bids for the bathroom updates submitted and considered. Gaier Construction in Black River Falls, and AmeriCon Construction in Sparta submitted bids. A motion was made by Kylee to approve the bid from Gaier Construction with a second by Grady. Carried.
