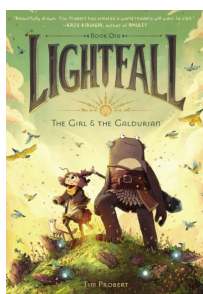

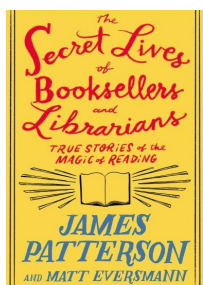


The Youth Summer Library Programs for children and families are:

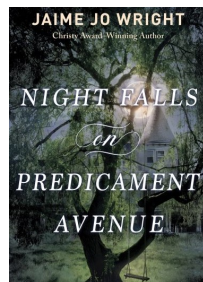
- *Summer Reading Program: forms available beginning June 24!
